Tiles perfect for a dogs' home

The client's brief required the floor finish in the new kennels to be hygienic, easily maintained and suitable for under-floor heating. Craven Dunnill recommended unglazed porcelain floor tiles with a slip resistant texture for the main kennels and glazed porcelain floor tiles for the reception and grooming area. All the ranges specified have a fully vitrified porcelain body, which is ideal for maintaining hygienic, sterile conditions, and have a durable and hard-wearing finish to withstand frequent cleaning.

The Cheshire Dogs' Home is in Warrington and has operated as a charity since 1893. The completed £400k extension is a much-needed addition to the centre in order to cater for the special needs of dogs which are elderly, those expecting and as a crèche for newly arrived puppies. The ceramic tiles were specified by the main contractor P.J. Building from Stoke-on-Trent.

The tiles supplied by Craven Dunnill were a combination of structured surface tiles in grey 300 x 300mm from Carofrance for the special unit kennel area, Samsara beige 600 x 600mm with wood effect listel from Tau for the entrance hall and Basalto Ocre 450 x 450mm, also from Tau, for the grooming area.
