Available in 250 x 110mm at around £36.00 m² for the damask-styled décor tiles and around £32.75 m² for the coordinating field tiles.

Extreme tile sizes are now affordable and no longer limited to the niche, designer market. Craven Dunnill's new **Scandi Wood porcelain floor and ceramic wall tile** range boasts a mega-long and wide 1200mm by 298mm plank-tile format.

Featuring a faithfully replicated sawn-wood texture and appearance, Scandi Wood is available in a palette of six subtle colours, chosen to work with most décor schemes, and retails at around £49.50m².

3. Tiles that add value to the home

Whilst naturals such as wood and stone-look ceramic tiles have never been out of fashion, Craven Dunnill predicts that many buyers will be turning to natural aesthetics with added detailing as they

look to achieve a fresh look and add value to their home. Ticking all the boxes, the **Dover stone-look wall and floor tile range**, featuring stylish chiselled and striated wall tile detailing and a matt stone floor tile effect, is predicted to be a winner.

The Dover glazed porcelain floor tiles are available in two colours: Chalk and Smoke, 450 x 450 mm and retail at around £28.80m²; the striated wall tiles are available 500 x 250mm and plain field tiles 500 x 250mm, both retailing at around £27.35m².
